CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- The competition is open to anyone (professional, amateur or emerging artist).
- Maximum 2 entries per person.
- **Entries open 1st July 2022.** Entry forms are available from the webpage or at the Loxton Library & Visitor Information Centre, 25A East Terrace and must include an Artist Statement.
- There is a non-refundable entry fee of **\$10** per entry.
- Entry forms must be completed in full and lodged **with entry fee and Artists Statement**, either at the Loxton Library & Visitor Information Centre, 25A East Terrace, Loxton or via email to admin@loxtonchamber.com.au by **5pm Friday 5 August 2022.**
- Entries will be accepted in 3 categories: Open (19 yrs +) no theme.
 Teen (13-18 yrs) no theme.
 Youth (7-12 yrs) theme: River Monsters
- Categories will be judged separately, and a People's Choice prize awarded for Teen & Open categories.
- Cash Prizes will be: Open - Winner \$1,000, Merit \$700, People's Choice \$700.
 Teen - Winner \$250, Merit \$150, People's Choice \$150.
 Youth - Winner \$50
- A minimum of 5 entries per category must be received for sculptures to be judged and prizes awarded. The judges' decision is final.
- All sculptures must be composed of predominately discarded, salvaged, reused or recycled materials not previously entered in this competition.
- Sculpture will be judged on originality, creativity, construction and technical ability.
- Materials for sticking, fixing, joining, gluing etc. may be new, but take the challenge to recycle, reclaim, borrow etc. where possible.
- Sculpture must be no larger than 2m (length) x 2m (width) x 1.5m (height). Actual size to be indicated on Entry Form.
- Sculpture to be freestanding or self-supporting. Indicate preference of tabletop or floor* on entry form to assist with allocation of display space. **Protection must be used to safeguard floor tiles.*
- All decisions pertaining to the display of the sculptures is at the discretion of the competition organiser.
- In the event that a sculpture is deemed unsuitable or does not meet the competition criteria, the competition organiser reserves the right to withdraw it from the competition.
- Sculptures are entered and exhibited at the artists' own risk. The competition organiser accepts no responsibility/liability for any damage incurred to the sculpture during the exhibition. It is the artists responsibility to arrange insurance protection for the sculpture if deemed necessary.
- **All sculptures are required to be displayed for judging at Riverland Motor Group, 1 East Terrace on Sunday 14th August 2022 between 10am and 3pm.** Winners will be announced at 1.30pm.
- Sculptures can be delivered and set up at Riverland Ford, 1 East Terrace on either Saturday 13th August 2022 from 3pm - 5pm, or Sunday 14th August 2022 from 9am - 10am.
- Sculptures are to be collected on Sunday 14th August 2022 between 3pm - 4pm. Sculptures not collected by 4pm will be held at Riverland Motor Group for a maximum of 2 days. After this time the sculpture will be disposed of.
- Artists agree to their names and images of their entries being used for promotional purposes.
